INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove 3 factory screw from wheel well holes #5 to #7.
- 3. Loosely install mount clip (g) on mud flap hole #2 using a cap screw (a), black oxidized washer (c), & nylon washer (e).
- 4. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #3 into factory hole #6 using supplied sheet metal screw (b), oxidized washer (d) & nylon washer (f)
- 5. Slide the mount clip (g) on hole #2 behind the fender lip.
- 6. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #1 to factory hole #5 using supplied sheet metal screw (b), oxidized washer (d) & nylon washer (f)
- 7. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #4 into factory hole #7 using supplied sheet metal screw (b), oxidized washer (d) & nylon washer (f)
- 8. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners.
- 9. Repeat procedure for passenger side.



- 4. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #2 into factory hole #5 using supplied sheet metal screw (b), oxidized washer (d) and nylon washer (f)
- 5. Slide the mount clip (g) on hole #1 behind the fender lip.
- 6. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #3 into hole #6 and through hole #4 into hole #7 using supplied sheet metal screws (b), oxidized washers (d), and nylon washers (f).
- 7. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners.
- 8. Repeat procedure for passenger side.
