INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Before you install your Evaporator Canister Guard see the diagrams and parts list for all necessary parts.
- 2. Remove the factory screw #1 in front of the factory canister (see diagram #1) and install support strap bracket through the factory screw hole #1 with the fasteners a, c and d (see diagram #2). Make sure the support strap bracket is parallel to the factory canister before tightening the screw a.
- 3. Remove factory screws #2 and #3 at the rear end of the factory canister (diagram #2) and loosely install the evaporator canister guard through the factory screw hole #2 hole with the fasteners a, c and d (diagram #3). Make sure the two slotted holes in front of the guard are lined up with the two clinch nuts on the Support strap bracket (diagram #3) then secure the guard through the factory screw hole #3 with the fasteners a, c and d (diagram #3).
- 4. Secure the front end of the guard to the support bracket with the fasteners 2x b, 2x c and 2x d then tightening the screw on the factory screw hole #2.
