TOOLS REQUIRED:



Electric or re-chargeable ½" or 3/8" drill.



¼" Drill bit



c) (8) Washer, Nylon 0.281" x 1" Part #054085



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Before you install your upper mounts, see the Diagram #1 and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the Driver's Side.
- 2. Square the flap with the tire while holding the flap up against the wheel well and the offset flange tuck underneath the wheel well. (See Diagram #1)
- 3. Locate the center of the wheel well or wheel flare on the back side of the stainless steel panel and drill four 1/4" holes from 'A' to 'D' on the stainless steel panel only.

Note: Drill with caution, do not drill through the wheel well or wheel flare.

- 4. Secure the flap with four nylon washers four flat washers and four tek screws on hole 'A' to 'D'.
- 5. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.
