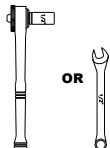

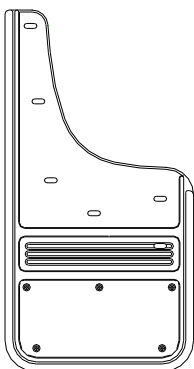

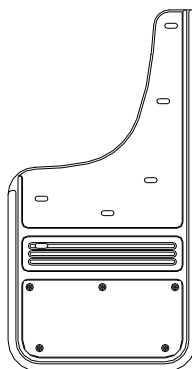

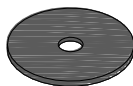
a) (8) Sht Mtl Screw

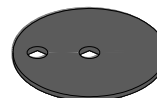
b) (4) Sht Mtl Screw

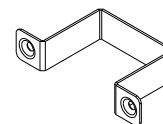
d) (2) Washer, Offset

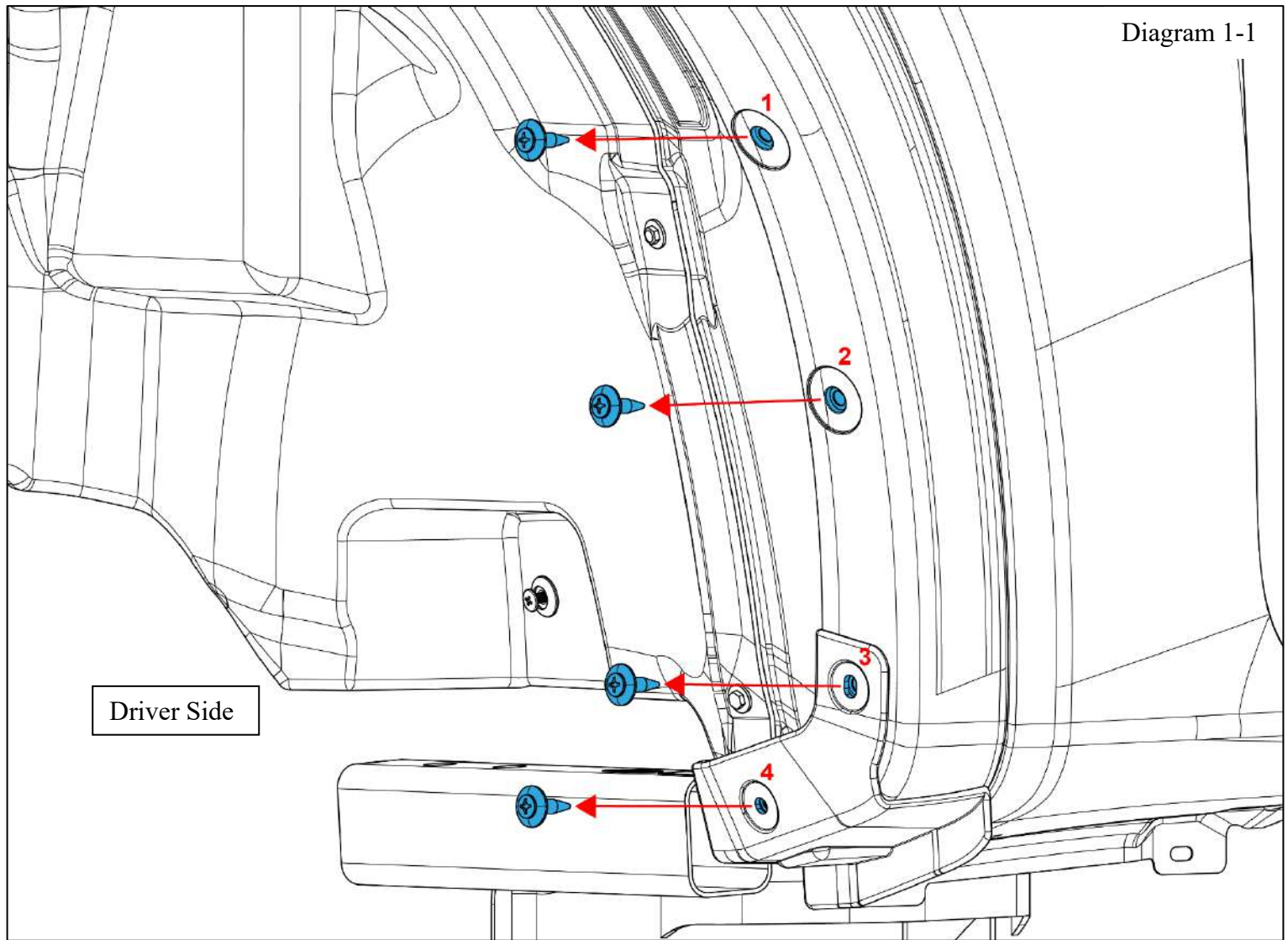

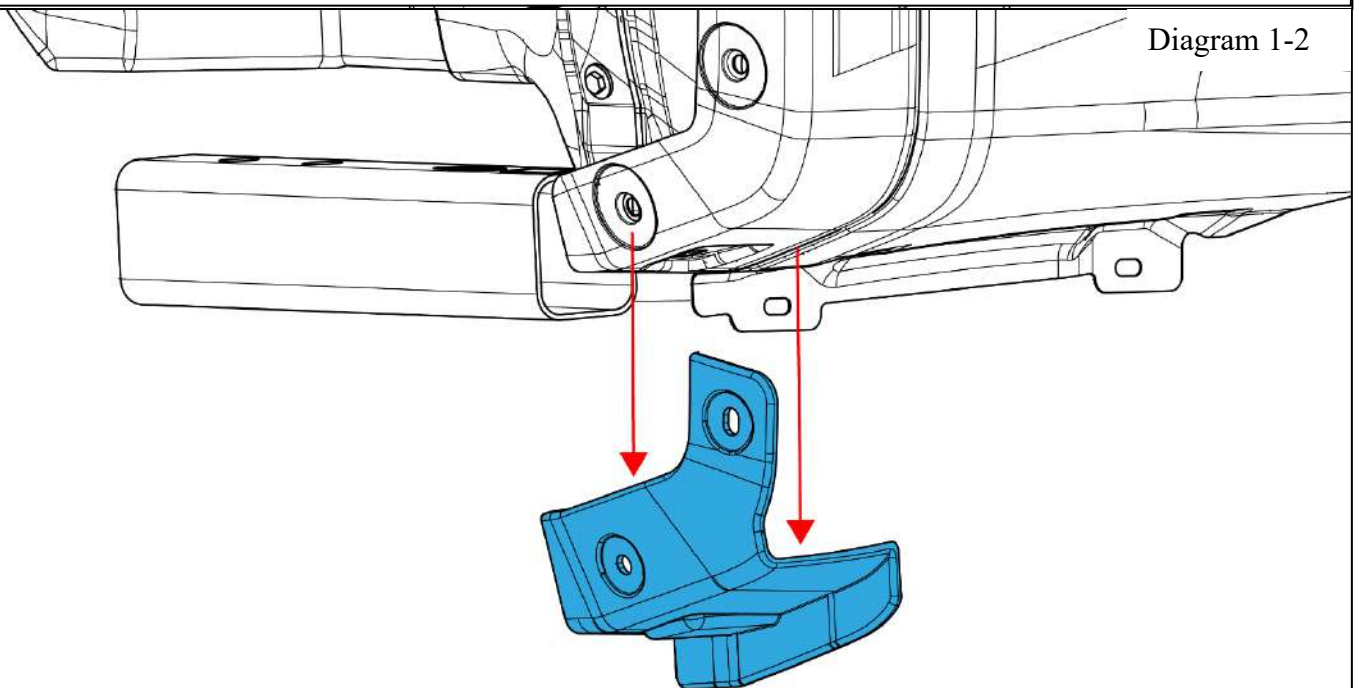

Diagram 1-1



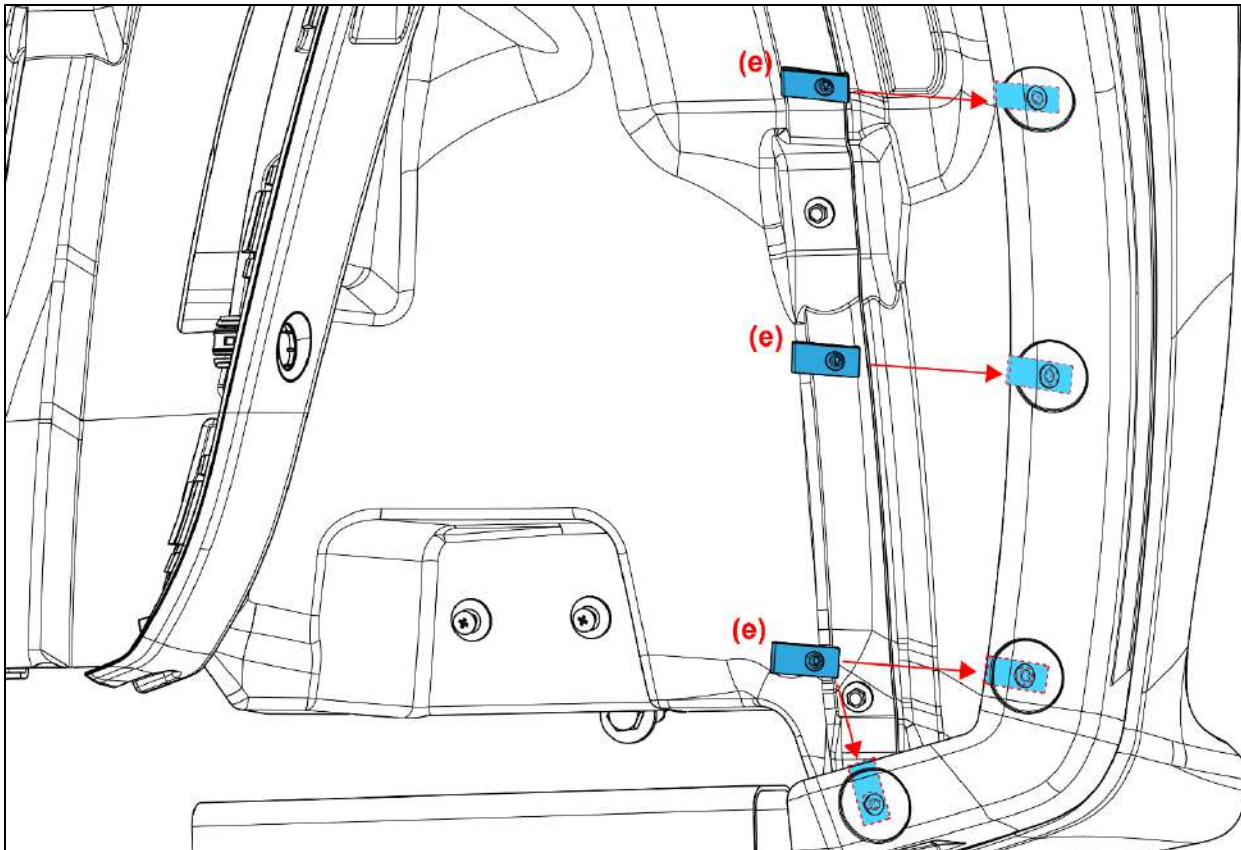
1-1: Remove the 4 factory push pins on the fender. Discard.

Diagram 1-2



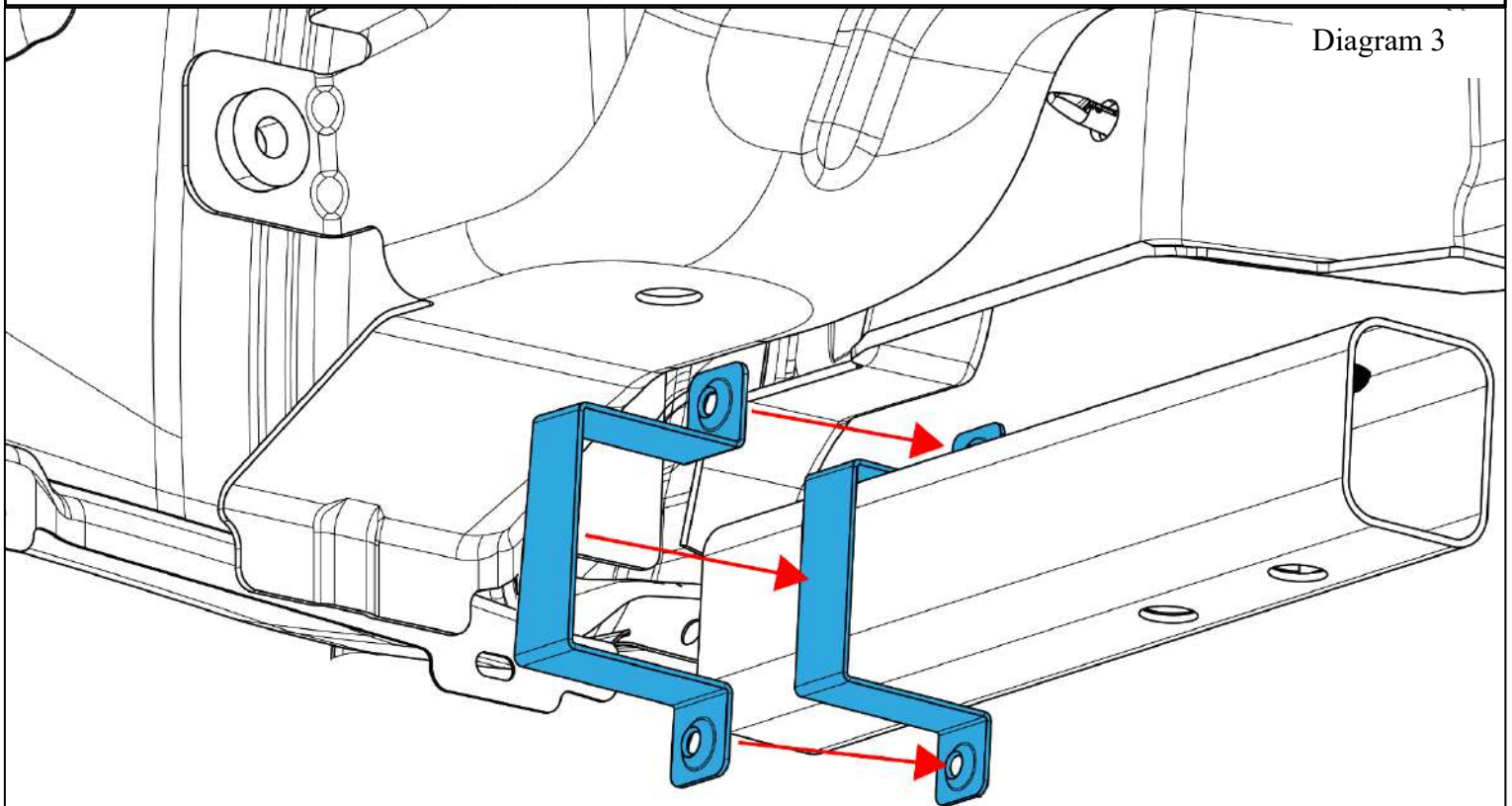
1-2: Remove the factory impingement guard. Discard.

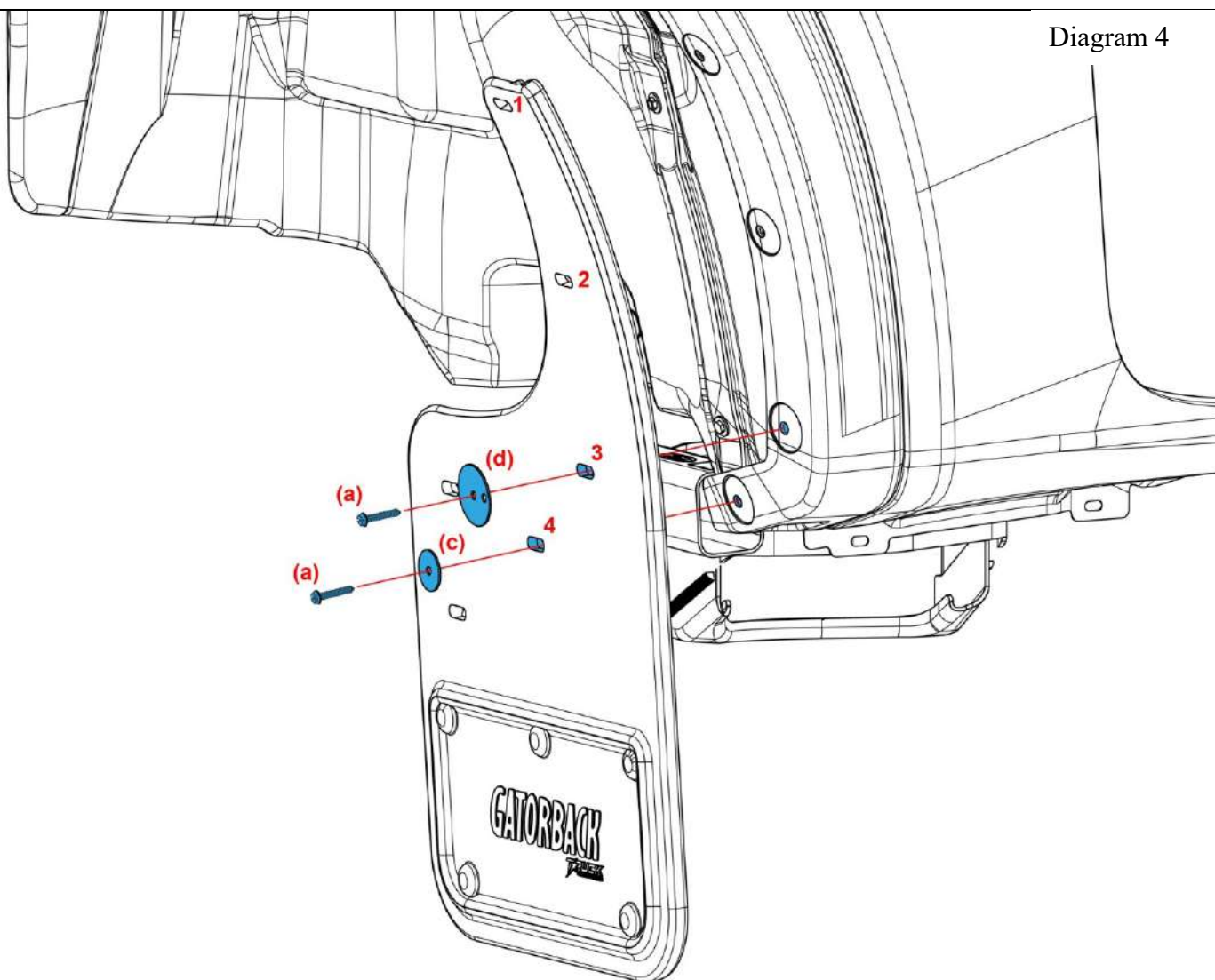
2: Install spring nut (e) on factory holes where push pins were removed. Note that the protruding side of the clip should be facing inward, with the flat side laying between the sheet metal and the plastic wheel lip.
Tip: Ensure that the holes in the spring nut are aligned properly with the factory holes by putting one of the supplied screws through the factory holes and into the spring nut.

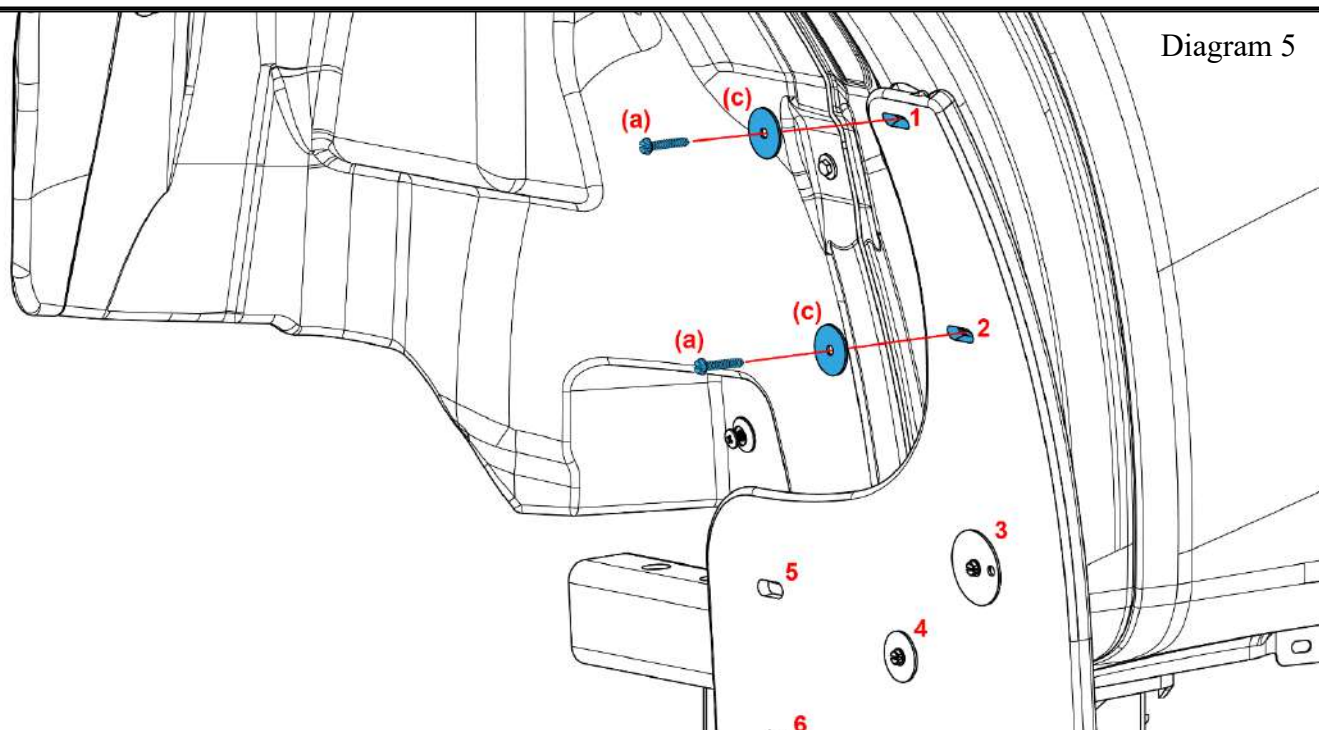
3: Install bracket on impact bar from behind so that the flanges face the tire.

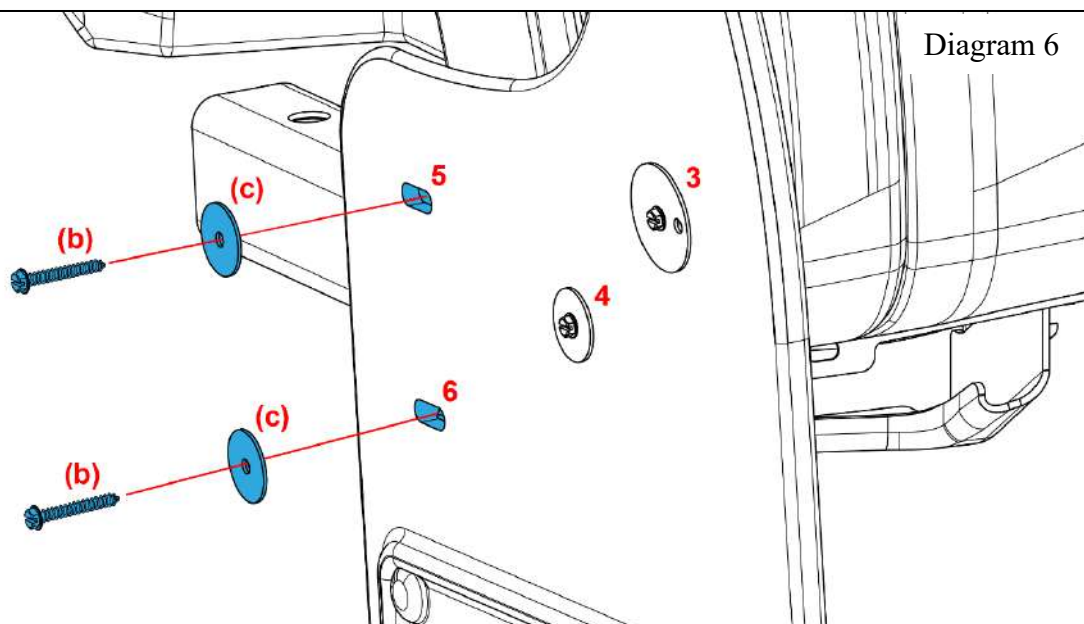
4: Loosely install hardware as shown

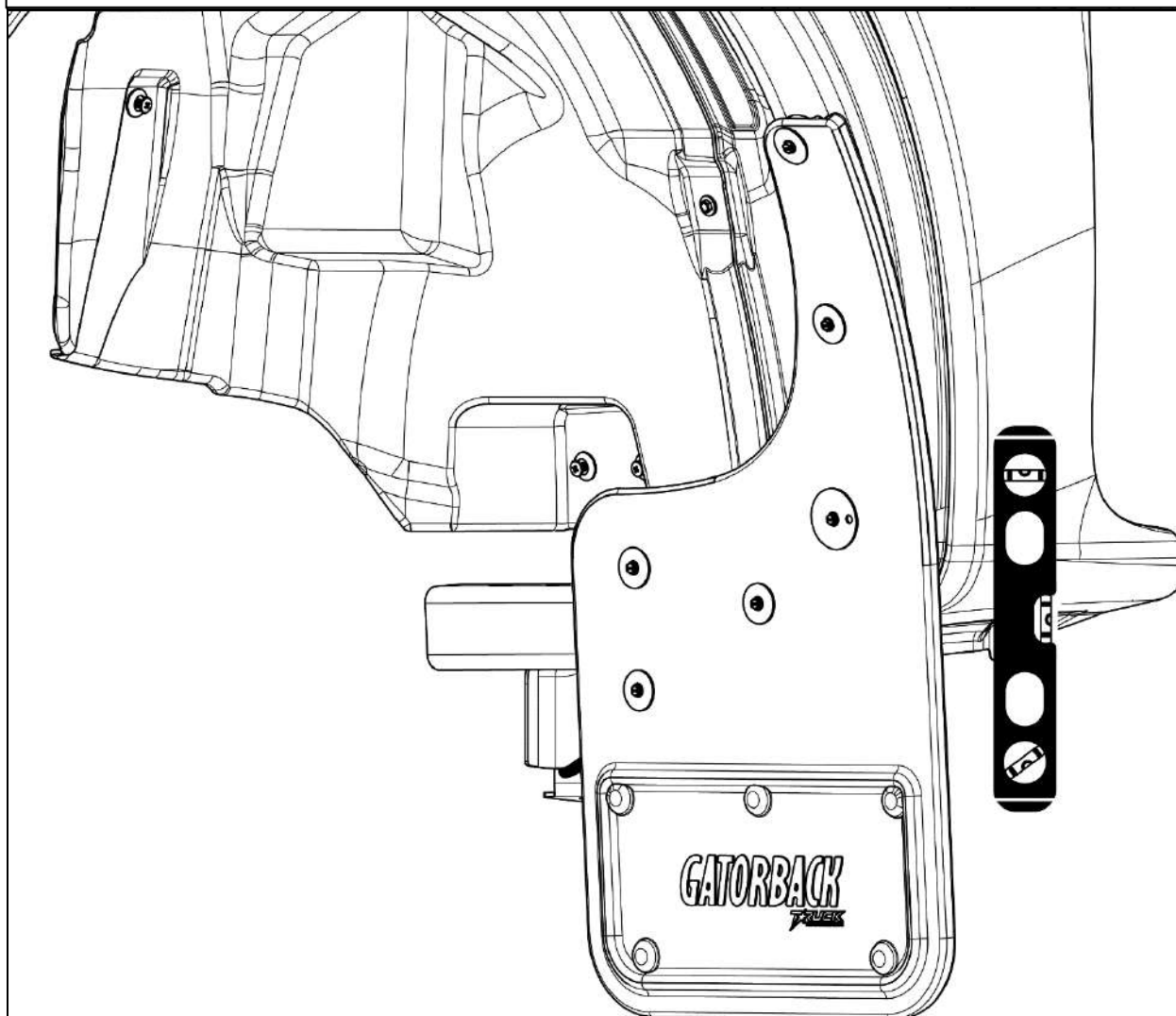
5: Loosely install hardware as shown
