




TOOLS REQUIRED:



#2 Phillips screwdriver



11/32" wrench or socket wrench



13 mm wrench or socket wrench

INSTALLATION

For ease of installation, it is suggested that the wheel be removed.

1. Fasten the LH mount bracket to the left hand flap with 3 machine screws / small washers and nylock nuts to Holes #1, #2 and #3 or, if you prefer the flap mounted higher and farther away from the ground than use Holes #4, #5 and #6. See Diagram #1.





2. Remove the 3 factory body bolts and reinstall through the LH mount bracket Holes #7, #8 and #9 with the LH mount bracket facing the rear of the vehicle. See Diagram #2. Loosely secure at this point.

✓ Check all fasteners for tightness. Repeat procedure on the other side.
