


INSTALLATION - Start with installation of Truck Hardware Finishing Cap

(For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

CAPS:


- 1. Remove the 4 factory screws from the existing factory guard. Set this hardware aside for later reinstallation.
- 2. Because there is no external access to the interior push pin like on the rear guard, the front guard must be pulled off by hand.
- 3. Slightly peel back the red 3M tape on the finishing cap and fold back so it can be fully peeled after cap is in place.
- 4. Position cap, ensuring the top lip of the cap slides under the fender molding as shown.
- 5. If installing Gatorback Mud Flaps, reinstall the two factory screws on the underside of the finishing cap. If no flaps are being installed, reinstall the four factory screws to secure the cap. Be careful not to overtighten.
- 6. Finish peeling 3M tape and press firmly on the bottom and side of the finishing cap to ensure a proper seal.
- 7. Repeat procedure on passenger side.



FINISHING CAP (GUARD) DRIVER SIDE SHOWN

MUD FLAPS:

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove factory screw from wheel well hole #6. *Note* Factory screws on holes #7 & #8 will have been removed during cap installation.
- 3. Using a ¼" drill bit, drill a hole through the finishing cap hole #9 into the factory liner.
- 4. Install the front nut (i) between the factory liner and the finishing cap, aligning the clip with finishing cap hole #9.
- 5. Loosely install mount clip (g) on mud flap hole #2 using a cap screw (d), stainless steel washer (a), and nylon washer (c).
- 6. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #3 into hole #7 using a supplied screw (e) and washer (b).
- 7. Install mount clip on hole #2 behind the fender lip.
- 8. Loosely secure mud flap through holes #1 & #4 into factory holes #6 using supplied sheet metal screw (e) and stainless steel washer (b).
- 9. Loosely secure mud flap hole #5 through hole #9 into the front nut using a sheet metal screw (e) and flat washer (b)
- 10. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners.
- 11. Repeat procedure for passenger side.




INSTALLATION - Start with installation of Truck Hardware Finishing Cap

(For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

CAPS:

- 1. Remove the 4 factory screws from the existing factory guard. Set this hardware aside for later reinstallation.
- 2. Use a 5/16" socket on an extension to collapse the push pin on the inside of the factory cap. You can reach the push
 - pin through the cavity of the fender (See video).
- 3. Slightly peel back the red 3M tape on the finishing cap and fold back so it can be fully peeled after cap is in place.
- 4. Position cap, ensuring the top lip of the cap slides under the fender molding as shown.
- 5. If installing Gatorback Mud Flaps, reinstall the two factory screws on the underside of the finishing cap. If no flaps are being installed, reinstall the four factory screws to secure the cap. Be careful not to overtighten.


 Note On the rear caps, the empty screw slot on the cap is specifically for our Gatorback mud flap installation and has no corresponding factory screw.
- 6. Finish peeling 3M tape and press firmly on the bottom and side of the finishing cap to ensure a proper seal.
- 7. Repeat procedure on passenger side.

MUD FLAPS:

- 2. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove factory screw from wheel well hole #9. *Note* Factory screws on holes #7 & #8 will have been removed during cap installation.
- 3. Loosely install mount clip (g) on mud flap holes #1 & #2 using a cap screw (d), stainless steel washer (a), and nylon washer (c).
- 4. Install the rear nut (i) between the factory liner and the finishing cap, aligning the clip with finishing cap hole #12.
- 5. Install mount clips (g) on holes #1 #2 behind the fender lip.
- 6. Loosely secure mud flap hole #6 through cap hole #12 into rear clip using supplied sheet metal screw (e) and stainless steel washer (b).
- 7. Loosely secure mud flap through holes #4 & #5 into holes #7 & #8 using supplied screw (e) and washer (b).
- 8. Loosely secure mud flap through #3 into hole #9 using a supplied screw (e), washer (b), and HDPE washer (f)
- 9. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners.
