


IMPORTANT:

The manufacturer is not responsible for negligent use of vehicle with mud flaps installed, including over-tightening of screws and bolts causing damage to vehicle or mud flaps.




INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Before you install your upper mounts, see the Diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the Driver's Side.
- 2. Square the flap with the tire while holding the flap up against the wheel well and the offset flange tuck underneath the wheel well. (See Diagram #3)
- 3. Locate the center of the wheel well or wheel flare on the back side of the stainless steel panel and drill four ¹/₄" holes from 'A' to 'D' on the stainless steel panel only.

Note: Drill with caution, do not drill through the wheel well or wheel flare.

- 4. Secure the flap with four flat washers and four tek screws on hole 'A' to 'D'.
- 5. Repeat procedure for the passenger side. Mud Flaps are now ready to install onto a vehicle.










DIAGRAM #3
