Rear, DS

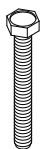


(1) Flap Assembly

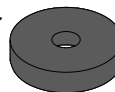
a) (2) Capscrew

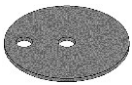
c) (10) Washer, Spacer

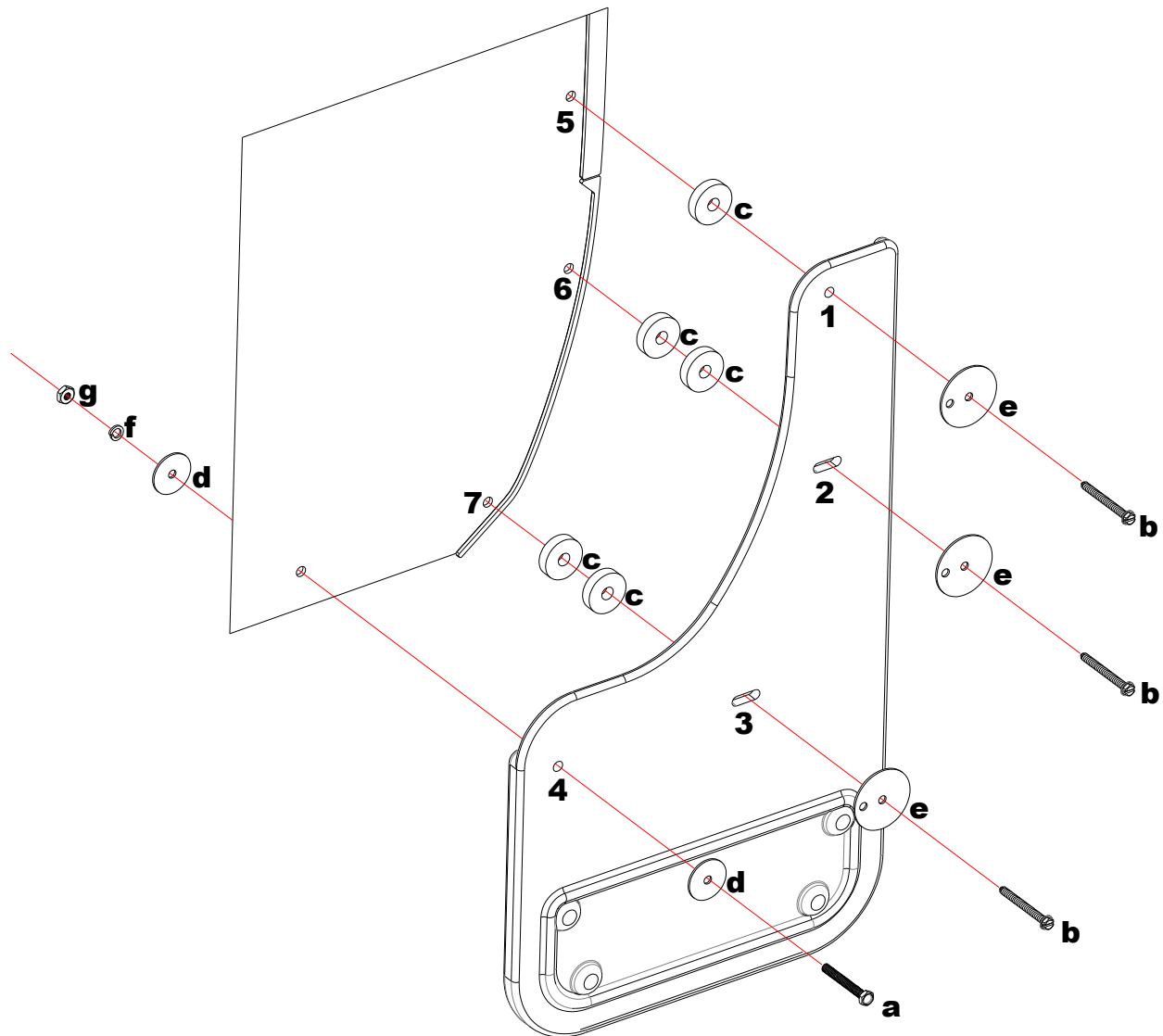

INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
2. Remove 3 factory screws from fender.
3. Loosely secure mudflap hole #3 through two spacer washers (c) to factory hole #7 using a sheet metal screw (b) and flat washer (e).

4. Loosely secure mud flap hole #2 through two spacer washers (c) to factory hole #6 using a sheet metal screw (b) and a flat washer (e).
5. Loosely secure mud flap hole #1 through one spacer washer (c) to factory hole #5 using a sheet metal screw (b) and a flat washer (e).
6. Hold mudflap against the liner and drill a 1/4" hole through mudflap hole #4 into factory plastic liner.
7. Loosely install mud flap hole #4 to hole made in factory liner using a capscrew (a) flat washer (d), and secure using a flat washer (d), lock washer (f), and hex nut (g)
8. Square the flap using a square or other leveling tool.
9. Tighten all fasteners.
10. Repeat procedure for passenger side.
