### **INSTALLATION** (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove factory screw from wheel well holes #5 & #6.
- 3. Loosely install mount clip (g) on mud flap hole #1 using a cap screw (e), black oxidized washer (a), & nylon washer (c).
- 4. Tuck the offset tab #4 underneath the factory plastic cap until the tab is fully engaged inside the factory plastic cap
- 5. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #2 into factory hole #5 using supplied sheet metal screw (f), oxidized washer (b) & nylon washer (d)
- 6. Install mount clip (g) on hole #1 behind the fender lip.
- 7. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #3 into hole #6 using supplied sheet metal screw (f), oxidized washer (b) & nylon washer (d)
- 8. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners.
- 9. Repeat procedure for passenger side.


(1)Flap Assy Rear, DS



### **INSTALLATION** (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove factory screw from wheel well holes #5 to #7.
- 3. Loosely install mount clip (g) on mud flap hole #1 using a cap screw (e), oxidized washer (a), and nylon washer (c).
- 4. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #2 into factory hole #5 using supplied sheet metal screw (f), oxidized washer (b) and nylon washer (d)
- 5. Install mount clip (g) on hole #1 behind the fender lip.
- 6. Loosely secure mud flap through hole #3 into hole #6 and through hole #4 into hole #7 using supplied sheet metal screws (f), oxidized washers (b), and nylon washers (d).
- 7. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners.
